## the Story

Husmatullah is a mechanic and has a workshop in one of prominent muslim locality of Allahabad. He is also an office bearer of the local mosque committee and is popular between peers and friends though not on good terms with the President of the committee Nawab Kasuri, a hardliner with a bitter history.

An old vintage engine comes to his workshop for repair which not only has a very significant national relevance but also is related to a very important event in the history. As he sets to get it started, things around him take a different turn. Working on some fresh leads the local police does some arrest which is opposed by the local mosque committee and the community leaders. In the ensuing protest a young innocent boy is killed leading to a call of general boycott from the mosque. Hasmat joins the boycott only to realize the importance of the work at hand.

As knowledge of the engine and its significance grows, Hasmatullah is drawn more and more towards a crossroad. As time and events grow around him, he finds himself standing on a rift with two sides parting away with every passing moment. He has to take his call which will not only rekindle his philosophy but also will lead his community to a process of realization of higher motives and higher responsibilities.



### about the film

India in particular and the world in general is passing through tough times. The menace of terrorism having spread globally has inflicted its fangs on the heartland of India as well; rather the menace has been troubling it for more than a decade or two. With global terrorism being interrelated to muslims population worldwide, the same thought have now taken deep believe into the psyche of general Indian masses. Today the whole muslim community is looked with suspicion, their loyalty and patriotism always questioned on the slightest pretext and they always at the receiving end for the misdeed of handful. With each new terror act, the gaze of suspicion intensifies, and the whole community keeps becoming more and more marginalized.

Based on this fulcrum, "Road to Sangam" tries to delve into the psyche of muslim community and tries to explore their insecurities, apprehensions, suffering and their understanding of call of nation and thus their actions. The story revolves around Hasmatullah, A 45-50 years old, bread earner of a big joint family and living in a muslim majority locality of Allahabad. Not much literate he is a very good mechanic of automobile units of old models, hard-working, loyal, firm believer of Islam and good-hearted man. Though a devout practitioner, he has a very modern outlook towards his religion eschewing radicalism and believing in progression and openness about it. He believes in understanding the true meaning of the religion and one of the principle he believes is that of live and let live and that of following the call of duty and belief of ones heart in spite of all oppositions. These ideas certainly do not make him popular with a section of his community.

One day though he stands at crossroads, of his call for the nation and the will of his community, which in present context stands against each other. He has to choose between what he believes is his duty as an individual and as a citizen, and the dictates of his community elders who want to stop him for doing that. As time passes, the choices become more and more difficult and he stands between ever increasing gulf. He chooses the vocation of his heart and the voice of his inner self and thus faces wrath of his community. Left isolated and humiliated, he decides to fight back. He sets himself on a journey to redeem all his friends and near and dear ones, one by one, by making them understand his belief and trying to make them realize the true understanding of duty and religion. His redemption leads to redemption of many others who are awakened to higher realities of life and see religion and their whole community from a new perspective.

In the end his inner voice triumphs and he succeeds to show a new path to everyone in these trying times of suspicion, hatred and pointing fingers.




